Details of the entrance exam



Dear Applicant!

With this information we would like to help you prepare for the entrance examination at VMI. If you still have questions afterwards, please feel free to contact us at any time.

Your motivation: An important aspect is your motivation to successfully complete a music degree. Therefore, before registering for the entrance exam, make sure that you not only want to deepen a passion, but that you want to pursue a professional career in the music industry.

Your previous experience: In addition to motivation, your prior knowledge is the most important factor in being accepted into a VMI degree program. To determine this, we will conduct a review of your practical skills and theoretical knowledge, which may be supplemented by an interview.

Your practical skills: To assess your motivation and practical skills, we need some videos from you. The videos can be professionally produced or simply made with a regular smartphone. Make sure that you are clearly recognizable on the videos (for music productions, please record yourself explaining your work on the computer). Depending on the intended course of study, we require the following videos:

a) 1 motivation video: For all degree programs;

b) 2 music videos: For all vocal, instrumental and songwriting studies;

c) 2 Music Productions: For Music Production and Electronic Music & Sound Design;

d) 2 Original Compositions: For Composition and Composition Pedagogy (alternatively, upload scores);

Your Videos: Upload your videos to You-Tube and include your YouTube links in your online application (if necessary, you may submit your links later). If you don't have your own YouTube channel yet, this is the best time to create one. It is very easy to create and can be done in a few steps for free:

- 1. Log in to YouTube through your browser;
- 2. Perform an action that requires a channel (e.g. upload video, post comment or create playlist);
- 3. If you don't have your own channel yet, a prompt to create one will now appear;
- 4. Check if the details are correct (e.g. the name of your Google account) and confirm your creation of a new channel;
- 5. After that, select the "Public" or "Unlisted" option to make sure we have access to your videos.

Your theoretical knowledge: To test your theoretical knowledge, we will conduct an online test with you lasting approximately 30-45 minutes. You will be presented with various audio examples and music theory questions that can be solved using multiple-choice answers. Since there are different requirements for the various courses of study, and since motivation and practical skills in particular are decisive for obtaining a place at university, not all test examples have to be solved without error in order to be accepted at the VMI. Examination result: After the evaluation of the online test and your videos, you will usually receive the result of your entrance examination within a few days. If the result is positive, you can then enroll and start your studies at VMI at the beginning of the next possible semester.

Persons from third countries: If you have a citizenship outside the European Union or do not have a valid residence permit for Austria, you will first receive a notice of admission after passing the entrance exam, which you can use to apply for a visa. You will find more information on the next page.

Persons from third countries



Information for non-EU citizens: Registration for the entrance examination is also possible at any time for persons from third countries (non-EU citizens) without a valid residence title (visa). However, a longer period of time must be planned for the issuance of a valid residence title. As a rule, several months pass between the issuance of an admission notice by the VMI after passing the entrance examination and the receipt of a residence title by the responsible authorities.

In the following overview, we have listed the necessary steps for admission to the VMI for persons from third countries:

- 1. Registration: An online registration for the entrance examination can be made by persons from third countries even without a valid residence title.
- 2. Entrance examination: Regardless of citizenship, passing an entrance examination is required to obtain a place at the VMI.
- **3. Admission notice:** After passing the entrance examination, persons from third countries without a valid residence title receive an admission notice with which they can apply to the authorities for the issuance of a residence title.
- **4. Enrollment:** After a valid residence permit has been submitted, persons from third countries can also enroll at the VMI.
- **5. Start of studies:** after completing the above-mentioned points, persons from third countries can commence their studies at the VMI at the beginning of the next possible semester.
